massacre

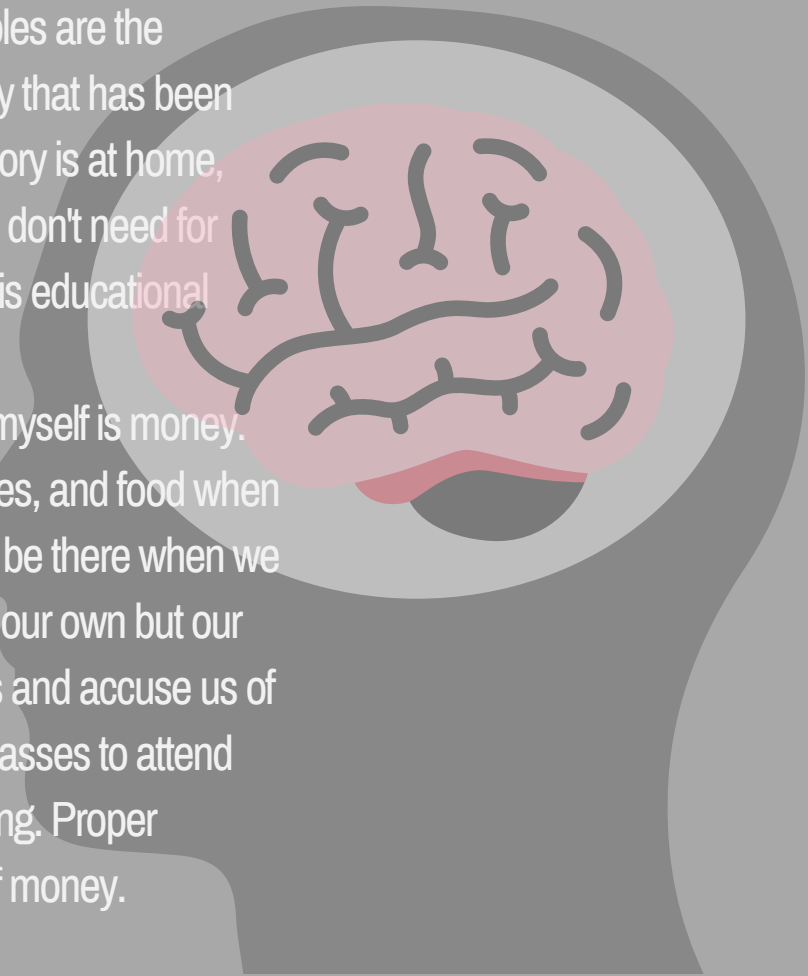

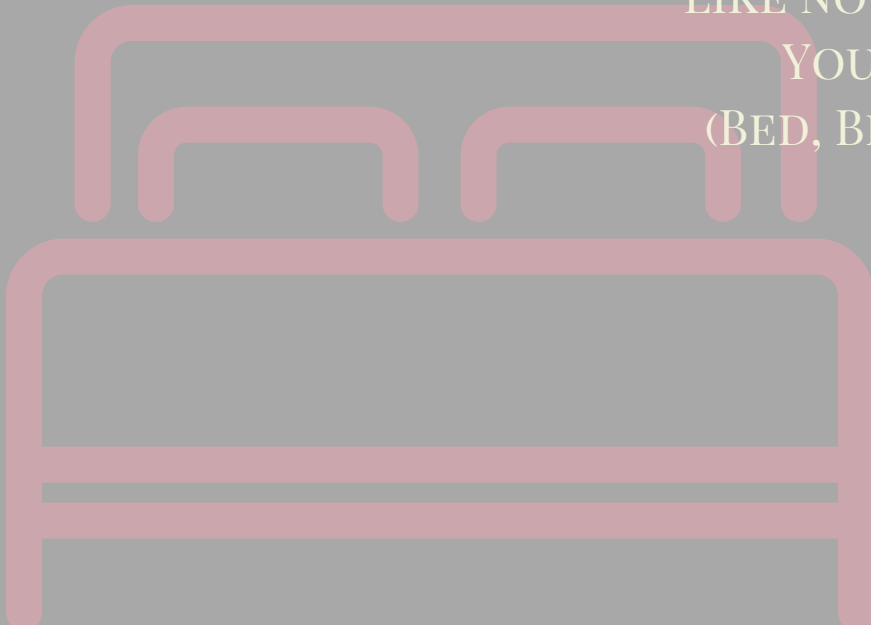

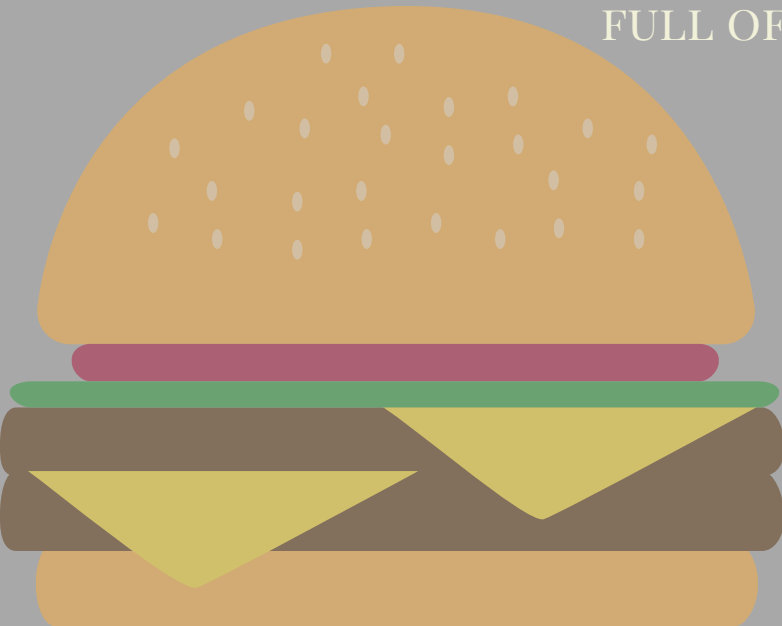
